3. Rationale Supporting the Use of the Selected Procurement Method (include state contract # or GSA contract # and expiration date)

The Department of Public Works has OM Partners under contract to manage and maintain the Medical Examiners facility. As the site manager, OM must secure in this emergency basis a reputable contractor to repair or replace parts related to the condenser for the chiller operations in the building without obtaining alternative bids for the repair services.

4. What other available options and/or vendors were evaluated? If none, include the reasons why.

Attempting to get alternative bids would delay repairs and stress the one existing piece of equipment.

5. What ultimately led you to this product or service? Why was the recommended vendor selected?

The Building Management service is responsible to facilitate repairs with approval of Public Works.

6. Provide an explanation of unacceptable delays in fulfilling the County's need that would be incurred if award was made through a competitive bid.

Delay in the repair could lead to damage on the current operational chiller unit as a result of one unit being used in place of two units.

7. Describe what future plans, if any, the County can take to permit competition before any subsequent purchases of the required supplies or services.

A new contract is in process and this situation will be considered to insure that any similar re-occurrence will be will have specifications identified for emergency repairs.

The site's Building Management Services in accordance with our contract, will have a service company prepare a quote for the emergency repair of the chiller unit and submit it to DPW for approval. The repairs must begin at the first opportunity to prevent undue stress or failure of the remaining chiller unit avoiding further expenditures.
