Angela Newman shared a link to a video about safe sleep practices with the group.	2 Recent Child Fatalities – 1. The legal custodian and her partner have been arrested and charged with murder 2. The death was deemed accidental due to unsafe sleep. Discussion about how to educate about safe sleep and caregiver screening.
	Child Protection Teams – The County Executive is committed to the Child Protection Team concept and budget is being assessed to move forward. It is a slow process. Andrew Garner shared that



	there are not enough child abuse pediatricians in the county. Therefore, this is a priority.
