## 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Simon called the meeting to order at 3:05 p.m.
2. ROLL CALL

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MAY 22, 2024 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Conwell, seconded by Ms. Stephens and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the May 22, 2024 meeting.
5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
a) R2024-0199: A Resolution awarding a total sum, not to exceed \$5,000, to the Building and Leveraging Opportunities Foundation for the purpose of providing 60 bicycles to Warrensville City Schools from the

District 9 ARPA Community Grant Fund; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Orlando Grant, Board Chair of Building and Leveraging Opportunities Foundation, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2024-0199. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Grant pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Schron with a second by Ms. Simon, Resolution No. R20240199 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.
