1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Tuma called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Tuma asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Tuma, Miller, Conwell and Sweeney were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Turner was absent from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE APRIL 19, 2023 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Sweeney, seconded by Ms. Conwell and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the April 19, 2023 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2023-0120</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Resolution No. R2019-0034 dated 2/12/2019, which authorized Department of Public Works, to acquire the necessary Rights-of-Way to proceed with the reconstruction and widening of Sprague Road-Phase 1 from Webster Road to West 130th Street in the Cities of Middleburg Heights, North Royalton, Parma and Strongsville; to change Parcel No.

90-WD, CH & T(Warranty Deed, Channel Easement & Temporary Easement) to Parcel 90WD, CH, A & T (Warranty Deed, Channel Easement, Aerial Easement & Temporary Easement); directing the County Executive, through the Department of Public Works, to proceed with the acquisition of real property required for public highway purposes; authorizing the Fiscal Officer to issue the monetary warrants to be deposited with the Probate Court of Cuyahoga County in an amount that is equal to the fair market value of the property; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Resolution No. R2023-0141

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County received \$239,898,257 from the Federal Government through the American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA"); and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County calculated 100% of the ARPA dollars as loss revenue under the U.S. Department of the Treasury Final Rule; and

WHEREAS, since all the ARPA dollars have been calculated as loss revenue, the ARPA dollars have been deposited in the County's General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive and County Council have authorized \$86 million of the ARPA dollars for community grants to benefit the residents of Cuyahoga County (the "ARPA Community Grant Fund"); and

WHEREAS, of the \$86 million for community grants, \$66 million have been encumbered for equal distribution to each County Council District; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Council desires to provide funding from the District 8 ARPA Community Grant Fund in the amount of \$150,000 to the Village of Brooklyn Heights for the purpose of upgrading and repairing elevators in the Brooklyn Heights municipal building and community center; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn Heights estimates approximately 15,000 people will be served annually through this award; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn Heights estimates the total cost of the project is \$315,430; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn Heights indicates the other funding source(s) for this project includes:

- A. \$138,793 from the Village of Brooklyn Heights;
- B. \$25,637 from surplus ARPA funds previously requested and approved for the Brooklyn Heights Community Services Bus Replacement Project; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Brooklyn Heights requested \$150,000 from the District 8 ARPA Community Grant Fund to complete this project; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Council desires to provide funding in the amount of \$150,000 to the Village of Brooklyn Heights, and to reallocate funding previously awarded pursuant to Resolution R2022-0306 in the amount of \$25,637, to ensure this project is completed; and

WHEREAS, this Council by a vote of at least eight (8) members determines that it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue to provide for the usually, daily operations of the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby awards a not-to-exceed amount of \$150,000 to the Village of Brooklyn Heights from the General Fund made available by the American Rescue Plan Act revenue replacement provision for the purpose of upgrading and repairing elevators in the Brooklyn Heights municipal building and community center.

SECTION 2. The Village of Brooklyn Heights is hereby authorized to reallocate \$25,637 in surplus funding previously awarded pursuant to Resolution R2022-0306 for the Community Services Bus Replacement Project and utilize those dollars for the purpose of upgrading and repairing elevators in the Brooklyn Heights municipal building and community center.

SECTION 3. If any specific appropriation is necessary to effectuate this agreement, the Director of the Office of Budget and Management is authorized to submit the requisite documentation to financial reporting to journalize the appropriation.

SECTION 4. That the County Council staff is authorized to prepare all documents to effectuate said award.

SECTION 5. That the County Executive is authorized to execute all necessary agreements and documents consistent with said award and this Resolution.

SECTION 6. If requested or necessary, the Agency of the Inspector General or Department of Internal Audit is authorized to investigate, audit, or review any part of this award.

SECTION 7. To the extent that any exemptions are necessary under the County Code and contracting procedures, they shall be deemed approved by the adoption of this Resolution.

SECTION 8. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 9. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

REQUEST DESCRIPTION (Include the project name, a description of the project, why the project is important or needed, and timeline of milestones/tracking of the project):

Name of Project:

Elevator upgrade and repair in both the Municipal Building and Community Center.

Project Description:

Repair, modernization and achieve code-compliance of the Village Municipal Building and Community Center elevators.

Why Project is Important/Needed:

The elevators are currently in poor condition and not ADA-compliant. The Municipal Building elevator is 51 years old and the Community Center elevator is 45 years old. Both well beyond the Useful Life Benchmark of 20-25 years overall and 10-15 years past the average lifespan of the elevator cables.

It is our intent to be totally compliant with the ASME A71.1 / CSA B44 Safety Code for Elevators & Escalators and OSHA Code 1917.116 through this project.

Time of Milestone/Tracking of Project:

Once the agreement is signed and scheduled with the contractor, they have advised that the work will be slated for delivery on 12/15/2023. They have further specified that the work will take 5 weeks for each elevator with an anticipated completion date for both units by March 1, 2024.

IMPACT OF PROJECT:

Who will be served:

All Village personnel, residents and the many visitors to both our Municipal Center and Community Center will benefit from modernized and safe elevators. It is especially important for the elderly and disabled who visit our buildings that they be ADA-compliant.

How many people will be served annually:

Although impossible to submit an actual number, we anticipate an average of 15,000 staff, residents and visitors will travel through the Municipal Center and Community Center annually.

Will low/moderate income people be served; if so how:

The Village of Brooklyn Heights is steadfast in providing safe, accessible and welcoming facilities for all of our employees, residents and visitors.

How does the project fit with the community and with other ongoing projects:

Increased participation for all individuals to attend Council and Committee meetings, Court proceedings, visit our Building, Fire and Police Departments and the many meetings and events scheduled at the Community Center.

If applicable, how many jobs will be created or retained (specify the number for each) and will the jobs be permanent or temporary

All Village and contractor positions will be maintained.

If applicable, what environmental issues or benefits will there be:

All lighting, both in the unit and at the outside unit entrance will be replaced with LED lighting. The elevator regrade and repair project will occur in Municipal Building and Community Center on parcels of land owned by the Village of Brooklyn Heights and will not consist of any deep trench construction. Therefore no environmental issues will be encountered during the construction of this project.

If applicable, how does this project serve as a catalyst for future initiatives:

With upgrades completed, the Village will now be more likely to continue to upgrade these buildings (i.e., painting, remodeling, etc...) now that they are ADA-compliant.
