To amend Sections 604.01 through 604.05, 604.99, 603.04, and 603.091 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by various ordinances, relating to dogs that pose a threat to public safety, dog nuisances, and neglect of animals; to supplement the codified ordinances by enacting new Sections 604.06 and 604.07, relating to appeals process and severability; and to rename Chapter 604 to "Dogs that Pose a Threat to Public Safety."
