CUYAHOGA COUNTY COUNCIL WORK SESSION TUESDAY, AUGUST 9, 2011 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 4:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Council President Connally at 4:04 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Miller presented the Council with a proposed Biennial Operating Budget and Capital Improvements Program Ordinance, which states that the County Executive will submit a proposed two-year budget to Council in October of odd numbered years, then provide an updated budget to Council in November of even numbered years. Discussion ensued. Wade Steen, Fiscal Officer, and Matt Rubino, Director of the Office of Budget & Management, participated in the discussion as well.

Mr. Germana reported that he will be hosting a forum with the Northeast Ohio City Council Association on Thursday, September 15, 2011 at 7:00 p.m. in Council Chambers to discuss the County's sexennial reappraisal process.
