1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Schron called the meeting to order at 1:06 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Chairman Schron asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Schron, Jones, Greenspan and Simon were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Rogers was absent from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

No public comments related to the agenda were given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JANUARY 14, 2013 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Greenspan, seconded by Mr. Jones and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the January 14, 2013 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) <u>O2013-0005</u>: An Ordinance establishing a Reserve Policy for the Loan Forgiveness Portion of Loans supported by the Economic Development Fund, and declaring the necessity that this Ordinance become immediately effective.
  - b) <u>O2013-0006</u>: An Ordinance establishing a Reserve Policy for Doubtful Debt for Loans supported by the Economic Development Fund, and declaring the necessity that this Ordinance become immediately effective.
