1. CALL TO ORDER

At the request of Council President Connally, Councilmember Greenspan, Chair of the Council Operations & Intergovernmental Relations Committee, called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Greenspan asked Clerk Schmotzer to call the roll. Councilmembers Brady, Germana, Gallagher, Schron, Conwell, Hairston, Connally, Miller and Greenspan were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmember Simon entered the meeting shortly after the roll call was taken. Councilmember Jones was absent from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO AGENDA

Mr. William Tarter, member of the Charter Review Commission, addressed Council regarding issues of concern to him relating to proposed amendments to the Charter.

4. ITEMS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

a) R2014-0141: A Resolution providing for the submission to the electors of the County of Cuyahoga an amendment to add Article XIV to the Cuyahoga County Charter to provide that the right to vote is a fundamental right in the County and authorize the County to take action to protect and promote the right to vote, and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

b) R2014-0160: A Resolution providing for the submission to the electors of the County of Cuyahoga an amendment to Article II, Section 2.01 and Article III, Section 3.03 of the Charter of Cuyahoga County modifying the residency requirements for the offices of County Executive and County Council; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

for the year in which the appointment is made; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
