1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Greenspan, Germana, Hairston and Conwell were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmember Simon was also in attendance.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE SEPTEMBER 30, 2014 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Conwell, seconded by Mr. Germana and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the September 30, 2014 meeting.

 - a) R2014-0073: A Resolution authorizing a revenue generating Underlying Agreement with City of Cleveland in the minimum amount of \$2,365,658.95 per annum for operation of jail services for City Prisoners, effective 6/1/2014; authorizing a Lease in connection with said agreement in the amount not-to-exceed \$1.00 per annum for use of the City's Central Prison Unit located at 1300 Ontario Street, 6th Floor,

Mr. Colon and Mr. Hugh Shannon, Administrator of the Medical Examiner's Office, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0246. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Colon and Mr. Shannon pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
