6. MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

a) Discussion of the County's Finances, Budget and Debt Capacity

Mr. Christopher Murray, Interim Director, Office of Budget and Management, addressed the Committee regarding the County's finances including the 27<sup>th</sup> Pay Reserve, the 2014-2015 Biennial Budget, the impact of separating 1/4 % sales tax revenue and corresponding expenses and the County's debt capacity and future assumptions.
