## 1. CALL TO ORDER

  - a) R2015-0093: A Resolution authorizing the use of a portion of the proceeds of the Cuyahoga County Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2014 (County Facilities Improvement), in an aggregate principal amount not-to-exceed \$14,000,000.00 for the purposes of paying certain costs of demolition of blighted and nuisance properties and

making grants therefor; authorizing other actions related to the use of such proceeds; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
