## CUYAHOGA COUNTY HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES & AGING COMMITTEE MEETING WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17, 2015 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

  - a) <u>R2015-0113</u>: A Resolution making an award on RQ32388 to Adoption Network Cleveland in the amount not-to-exceed \$749,000.00 for permanency supportive services for the period 4/1/2015 - 3/31/2017; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Daphne Kelker, Contracts Administrator for the Division of Children & Family Services, and Ms. Tamara Chapman-Wagner, Deputy Administrator of the Division of Children & Family Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0113. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Kelker and Ms. Chapman-Wagner pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
