1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Jones asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Culek to call the roll. Committee members Jones, Conwell, Brown, Schron and Miller were in attendance and a quorum was determined.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MAY 20, 2015 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Schron, seconded by Mr. Miller and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the May 20, 2015 meeting.

  - a) R2015-0113: A Resolution making an award on RQ32388 to Adoption Network Cleveland in the amount not-to-exceed \$749,000.00 for permanency supportive services for the period 4/1/2015 3/31/2017; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Daphne Kelker, Contracts Administrator for the Division of Children & Family Services, and Ms. Tamara Chapman-Wagner, Deputy Administrator of the Division of Children & Family Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0113. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Kelker and Ms. Chapman-Wagner pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Jones with a second by Mr. Miller, Resolution No. R2015-0113 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

Sponsored by: County Executive Budish/Department of Health and Human Services/Cuyahoga Job and Family Services

A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1200421-01 with El Barrio Incorporated for job readiness, job search, job placement and job retention services for Ohio Works First cash assistance and food stamp recipients for the period 7/1/2012 -6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 12/31/2015 and for additional funds in the not-to-exceed \$632,429.00; amount authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution: declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Health and Human Services/ Cuyahoga Job and Family Services has recommended an amendment to Contract No. CE1200421-01 with El Barrio Incorporated for job readiness, job search, job placement and job retention services for Ohio Works First cash assistance and food stamp recipients for the period 7/1/2012 - 6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 12/31/2015 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$632,429.00.

WHEREAS, this amendment increases the total value of the contract in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,691,541.07; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded 85% by Federal TANF Funding and 15% by FAET Funding; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes an amendment to Contract No. CE1200421-01 with El Barrio Incorporated for job readiness, job search, job placement and job retention services for Ohio Works First cash assistance and food stamp recipients for the period 7/1/2012 - 6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 12/31/2015 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$632,429.00.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute the amendment and all documents consistent with this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County and the reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
