1. CALL TO ORDER

 - a) R2015-0222: A Resolution making an award on RQ34252 to Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County in the amount not-to-exceed \$602,000.00 for fiscal agent services for Families and Schools Together, Bright Beginnings

and Parent Services Programs in connection with the FY2016 Ohio Children's Trust Fund Grant Program for the period 10/1/2015 - 9/30/2016; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreement and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Robin Martin, Program Director of the Family & Children First Council; Mr. Robert Mengerink, Superintendent of the Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County; and Ms. Jennifer Dodd, Director of Operations and Development for the Educational Service Center of Cuyahoga County, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0222.
