1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Greenspan, Germana and Hairston were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Conwell was absent from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

No public comments were given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JULY 21, 2015 MEETING

A motion was then made by Mr. Greenspan, seconded by Mr. Germana and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the July 21, 2015 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2015-0152: A Resolution amending Resolution No. R2014-0102 dated 4/8/2014, which authorized the County Executive to accept, on behalf of the County, the donation of burial plots within Crown Hill Cemetery, Twinsburg, Ohio, from William Suhay, Jr. for the purpose of accommodating indigent burials, by changing the number of plots from four to eight and the approximate value from \$4,000.00 to \$8,000.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute all documents in

connection with the transfer of said property and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Hugh Shannon, Administrator of the Medical Examiner's Office, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0152. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Shannon pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Germana with a second by Mr. Hairston, Resolution No. R2015-0152 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.

b) R2015-0153: A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to accept, on behalf of the County, the donation of two burial plots within Whitehaven Memorial Park, Village of Mayfield, Ohio, from Society of St. Vincent de Paul valued at approximately \$2,000.00 for the purpose of accommodating indigent burials; authorizing the County Executive to execute all documents in connection with the transfer of said property and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Shannon addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0153. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Shannon pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Hairston with a second by Mr. Germana, Resolution No. R2015-0153 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.

c) R2015-0161: A Resolution authorizing an agreement with The MetroHealth System in the amount not-to-exceed \$607,747.96 for healthcare and management services for youth residing at the County Detention Center for the period 7/1/2015 - 12/31/2015; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreement and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Karen Lippmann, Deputy Director of Juvenile Court, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0161. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Lippmann pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Greenspan with a second by Mr. Germana, Resolution No. R2015-0161 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

A Resolution authorizing an amendment to CE1200346-01 Contract No. with Applewood Centers, Inc. for Staff Secure Shelter Program and Placement Planning Day Report services for the period 6/1/2012 - 6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 6/30/2016 and for additional funds in the \$705,360.00: amount not-to-exceed authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution: declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

WHEREAS, the County Executive on behalf of Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas/Juvenile Division has recommended an amendment to Contract No. CE1200346-01 with Applewood Centers, Inc. for Staff Secure Shelter Program and Placement Planning Day Report services for the period 6/1/2012 - 6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 6/30/2016 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$705,360.00; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of this project is to provide a day report center for Court-involved youth as an alternative to secure detention; and

WHEREAS, this amendment is being funded 100% by RECLAIM Ohio Grant Funds; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes an amendment to Contract No. CE1200346-01 with Applewood Centers, Inc. for Staff Secure Shelter Program and Placement Planning Day Report services for the period 6/1/2012 - 6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 6/30/2016 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$705,360.00.

SECTION 2. That the County Executive is authorized to execute the amendment and all documents consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County and the reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
