1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:08 p.m.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) <u>R2015-0170</u>: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1200346-01 with Applewood Centers, Inc. for Staff Secure Shelter Program and Placement Planning Day Report services for the period 6/1/2012 - 6/30/2015 to extend the time period to 6/30/2016 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$705,360.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other

documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Karen Lippmann, Deputy Director of Juvenile Court, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0170. Discussion ensued.
