1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Germana called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Germana asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Germana, Miller and Conwell were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Simon entered the meeting after the roll call was taken. Committee member Greenspan was absent from the meeting. Councilmember Brown was also in attendance.

A motion was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Ms. Conwell and approved by unanimous vote to excuse Mr. Greenspan from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE NOVEMBER 4, 2015 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Ms. Conwell and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the November 4, 2015 meeting.

5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

a) R2015-0228: A Resolution declaring that public convenience and welfare requires reconstruction of Tiedeman Road approaches to Interstate 480 in the City of Brooklyn; total estimated project cost \$1,400,000.00; finding that special assessments will neither be levied nor collected to pay for any part of the County's costs of said improvement; authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement of cooperation with said municipality in connection with said project; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Jamal Husani, Chief Transportation/Traffic Engineer, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0228. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Husani pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Germana with a second by Mr. Miller, Resolution No. R2015-0228 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

b) R2015-0229: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE11084-04 with Mt. Pleasant NOW Development Corporation for lease of office space for use by Department of Health and Human Services/Division of Senior and Adult Services for the period 10/1/2000 - 12/31/2015 to extend the time period to 12/31/2020 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,168,430.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Stan Kosilesky, Chief Deputy Engineer; Dr. Richard Jones, Administrator of the Division of Senior and Adult Services; and Mr. Thomas Jones, Director of Mt. Pleasant NOW Development Corporation, addressed Council regarding Resolution No. R2015-0229. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Kosilesky, Dr. Jones and Mr. Jones pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Miller with a second by Ms. Conwell, Resolution No. R2015-0229 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

Councilmember Brown and Committee members Germana and Miller requested to have their names added as additional co-sponsors to the legislation.

c) R2015-0230: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1000867-01 with The Near West Side Multi-Service Corporation dba May Dugan Center for lease of office space for use by Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas/Adult Probation Department for the period 8/1/2010 - 7/31/2015 to extend the time period to 7/31/2020 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$174,820.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Kosilesky and Mr. James Starks, Supervisor of the Adult Probation Department, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2015-0230. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Kosilesky and Mr. Starks pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Conwell with a second by Mr. Miller, Resolution No. R2015-0230 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

Mr. Miller requested to have his name added as an additional co-sponsor to the legislation.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Public Works has recommended an award on RQ33677 to Precision Environmental Company in the amount not-to-exceed \$721,000.00 for the Courthouse Building Fire Damper Prerenovation Project—Fire Damper Asbestos Abatement; and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of this project are to remove and dispose of regulated asbestos containing materials and environmental clean-up work throughout attic spaces and basement utility areas of the courthouse building; and

WHEREAS, the project is scheduled to begin February 1, 2016 and be completed August 1, 2016; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded by the Capital Projects fund; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby makes an award on RQ33677 to Precision Environmental Company in the amount not-to-exceed \$721,000.00 for the Courthouse Building Fire Damper Pre-renovation Project–Fire Damper Asbestos Abatement.

SECTION 2. That the County Executive is authorized to execute a contract in connection with said award and all documents consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health, or safety in the County; and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1500248-01 with Mark Schaffer Excavating & Trucking, Inc. for Cuyahoga County Airport Runway 6/24 Safety Area Improvements Project No. 1 in connection with the Airport Improvement Program for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$3,230,048.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that Resolution become immediately this effective.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/Department of Public Works/Division of County Engineer has recommended an amendment to Contract No. CE1500248-01 with Mark Schaffer Excavating & Trucking, Inc. for Cuyahoga County Airport Runway 6/24 Safety Area Improvements Project No. 1 in connection with the Airport Improvement Program for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$3,230,048.00; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal of this project is to provide improvements to the runway at the Cuyahoga County Airport located in Council District 11; and

WHEREAS, the project is expected to begin March 2016 and be completed by July 2016; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded with the General Fund -90% Reimbursable by FAA Grants; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes an amendment to Contract No. CE1500248-01 with Mark Schaffer Excavating & Trucking, Inc. for Cuyahoga County Airport Runway 6/24 Safety Area Improvements

Project No. 1 in connection with the Airport Improvement Program for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$3,230,048.00.

SECTION 2. That the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 3.
