1. CALL TO ORDER

 - a) R2016-0002: A Resolution approving an adjustment of the municipal boundary between the City of Cleveland and the City of Shaker Heights that bisects eight parcels of land on Van Aken Boulevard at the intersection with Sutton and Onaway Roads, in order to incorporate all of the land within the municipal boundary of the City of Shaker Heights; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
