 - a) <u>R2016-0123:</u> A Resolution authorizing a contract with Emerald Development and Economic Network, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed

\$1,443,480.00 for administration of the FY2015 Shelter Plus Care Sponsor-based Rental Assistance Program in connection with the HEARTH Act Homeless Assistance Grant Program for the period 8/1/2016 - 7/31/2017; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Ruth Gillette, Manager for the Office of Homeless Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2016-0123. Discussion ensued.
