  - a. <u>R2011-0159</u>: A Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into an amendment to Agreement No. AG1000201-01 with Department of Workforce Development for operation of the Employment Connection One-Stop System, Career Centers and Work Experience Program for the period 7/1/2010 6/30/2011 to extend the time period to 6/30/2012, to change the scope of services, effective 7/1/2011, and for additional funds in the amount of \$753,513.00.

Lisa Evans of LNE addressed the committee, explaining LNE's role in job readiness training; Jill Rizika of Towards Employment addressed the committee on TE's functions; Ingrid Angel, from WSEM- El Barrio also spoke. WSEM provides the only Spanish-speaking training. Each of these agencies provides similar services in different geographic areas; they help the unemployed or underemployed understand the workplace, attire, environment, on-line applications; they connect more hard to place population with community resources, if necessary

- VI. Presentation Department of Senior & Adult Services, David S. Dombrosky, Interim Director. Mr. Dombrowsky discussed DSAS' mission; staffing, budget and programmatic issues; one staff member works on advocacy issues; COSE affiliated Project COPE, helping caregivers who may be at risk of losing jobs to access community resources; quality assurance; community social services program; information and outreach; benefits checkup; community resources; DSAS is the only county agency in Ohio that provides longer-term case management referrals; Medicaid benefits; adult protective services mandated program; Home Support program. Maureen Crider-Wallace, head of Adult Protective Services addressed how APS works. Joe Gauntner, Deputy Chief of Staff noted that Cuyahoga County is looked to as a standard across the state for the provision of services.
