1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Miller called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

 - a) <u>O2012-0022:</u> An Ordinance designating an additional five percent of all collections of delinquent real property, personal property and manufactured and mobile home taxes and assessments to be deposited in the delinquent tax and assessment collection fund; and appropriating

such amount to the use of the Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation.

Mr. Gus Frangos, President and General Counsel of the Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation, and Mr. Paul Komlosi, Consultant, addressed the Committee regarding Ordinance No. O2012-0022. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Frangos and Mr. Komlosi pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Germana with a second by Mr. Jones, Ordinance No. O2012-0022 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.
