

## MINUTES

CUYAHOGA COUNTY HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES & AGING COMMITTEE MEETING THURSDAY, JUNE 21, 2012 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1<sup>ST</sup> FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Brady called the meeting to order at 1:10 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 7, 2012 MEETING

  - a) <u>R2012-0118</u>: A Resolution authorizing amendments to contracts with various providers for placement services for the period 10/1/2011 6/30/2012 for additional funds; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendments and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:

- 1) No. CE1100618-01 with Beech Brook in the amount of \$280,000.00.
- 2) No. CE1100619-01 with BHC Belmont Pines Hospital, Inc. in the amount of \$300,000.00.
- 3) No. CE1100630-01 with The Cleveland Christian Home Incorporated in the amount of \$404,000.00.

Ms. Elizabeth Nekoloff, Administrator, for the Division of Children and Family services, and Mr. Rick Werner, Director of the Department of Health and Human Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2012-0118. Discussion ensued.
