1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Brady called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 11, 2012 MEETING

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) R2012-0229: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1200211-01 with United Way of Greater Cleveland for food and allocation of funds for Hunger Centers serving needy residents in Cuyahoga County for the period 4/1/2012 12/31/2012 to extend the time period to 12/31/2013 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,095,450.00; and authorizing the County Executive to

execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution.

Mr. Joseph Gauntner, Deputy Chief of Staff for Health and Human Services; and Ms. Judith Simpson-Collins, Vice President for Community Impact at the United Way of Greater Cleveland; addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2012-0229. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Gauntner and Ms. Collins pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Jones with a second by Ms. Conwell, Resolution No. R2012-0229 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of rules.
