Representatives of the Department of Public Works and Juvenile Court explained the history of this aspect of the Juvenile Justice Project. Several Council members expressed concerns about the why the county was being asked to pay for a crosswalk which is the City of Cleveland's responsibility. After continued discussion, a motion was made and seconded to approve all funding for the resolution except for the crosswalk.
