

MINUTES CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING THURSDAY, DECEMBER 8, 2011 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 9:30 AM

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gallagher at 9:30 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

The clerk called the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Greenspan and Simon were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Mr. Miller was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE NOVEMBER 9, 2011 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Greenspan, seconded by Mr. Gallagher and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the November 9, 2011 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2011-0337: A Resolution authorizing an agreement with The MetroHealth System in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,300,000.00 for medical, psychiatric, dental and pharmacy services for the period 1/1/2012 12/31/2012; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreement and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Robert Reid, Sheriff, Cuyahoga County discussed the above resolution. A discussion ensued.

A motion was made by Mr. Greenspan with a second by Ms. Simon and approved by unanimous vote to amend the monetary amount of the above resolution from \$1,300,000.00 to \$1,550,000.00.

A motion was made by Mr. Greenspan with a second by Ms. Simon and approved by unanimous vote to move R2011-0337 to the full council for consideration at the December 13, 2011 meeting.

a) Discussion regarding the Corrections Center Jail Kitchen Renovation Project.

Ken Kosovar, Director of Corrections at the Office of the Sheriff presented updates and status of the Jail Kitchen Renovation Project. Discussion ensued.
