

MINUTES CUYAHOGA COUNTY HUMAN RESOURCES, APPOINTMENTS & EQUITY COMMITTEE MEETING THURSDAY, APRIL 5, 2012 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 10:00 AM

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Conwell at 10:13 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Deputy Clerk Barnhill called the roll. Committee members Conwell, Rogers and Gallagher were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 22, 2012 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Gallagher, seconded by Mr. Rogers and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the March 22, 2012 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2012-0055</u>: A Resolution making an award on RQ20292 to Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada in the amount of \$1,953,538.00 for group healthcare benefits for County employees and their eligible dependents including stop loss insurance for the period 1/1/2012 -12/31/2012; authorizing the County Executive to execute a contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Lisa Durkin, Deputy Director of Human Resource Operations, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2012-0055. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Ms. Durkin pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Conwell with a second by Mr. Rogers, Resolution No. R2012-0055 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for consideration with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of rules.

Chairwoman Conwell reported that the next Human Resources, Appointments & Equity Committee meeting will be held on Thursday, May 3, 2012 at 10:00 a.m. The agenda will include Ordinance No. O2012-0005, an Ordinance prohibiting inquiries about or consideration of criminal convictions of applicants for Cuyahoga County employment positions until the applicant has been offered conditional employment; establishing the criterion under which criminal records may be considered, and establishing exceptions.
