1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Simon called the meeting to order at 11:36 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Simon asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Simon and Connally were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Jones was absent from the meeting. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

In accordance with Rule 12F of the County Council Rules, Council President Connally appointed Councilmember Miller as a Member Pro Tem.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE OCTOBER 12, 2012 MEETING
