

MINUTES CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS, PROCUREMENT & CONTRACTING COMMITTEE MEETING THURSDAY, APRIL 26, 2012 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 11:00 AM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order at 11:04 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Assistant Deputy Clerk Thurman called the roll. Committee members Jones, Miller and Rogers were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee members Conwell and Germana were absent from the meeting.

A motion was then made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Rogers and approved by unanimous vote to excuse Ms. Conwell and Mr. Germana from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

No public comments were given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE APRIL 19, 2012 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Miller, seconded by Mr. Rogers and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the April 19, 2012 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2012-0074</u>: A Resolution declaring that public convenience and welfare requires resurfacing of Denison Avenue from Fulton Road to

Pearl Road in the City of Cleveland; total estimated construction cost \$850,000.00; finding that special assessments will neither be levied nor collected to pay for any part of the County's costs of said improvement; and authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement of cooperation with said municipality in connection with said project.

Ms. Bonnie Teeuwen, Director of Public Works, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2012-0074. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Teeuwen pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Miller with a second by Mr. Rogers, Resolution No. R2012-0074 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of rules.

b) <u>R2012-0075</u>: A Resolution declaring that public convenience and welfare requires resurfacing of Riverview Road from Brookside Road to Fitzwater Road in the Cities of Brecksville and Independence; total estimated construction cost \$600,000.00; finding that special assessments will neither be levied nor collected to pay for any part of the County's costs of said improvement; and authorizing the County Executive to enter into agreements of cooperation with said municipalities in connection with said project.

Ms. Teeuwen addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2012-0075. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. Teeuwen pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Jones with a second by Mr. Rogers, Resolution No. R2012-0075 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of rules.
