CUYAHOGA COUNTY EDUCATION, ENVIRONMENT & SUSTAINABILITY COMMITTEE WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2013 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 3:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Rogers called the meeting order at 3:35 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Rogers asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Rogers, Simon and Germana were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

Per Council Rules 2F and 12F, Vice President Brady appointed Councilmember Miller as a Member Pro Tem of the Education, Environment & Sustainability Committee.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

Dr. Rebekah Dormand, Executive Director of the Office of Early Childhood-Invest in Children, and Ms. Nora Hurley, Deputy Law Director, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2013-0255. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Dr. Dormand and Ms. Hurley pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

A motion was then made by Mr. Germana, seconded by Ms. Simon and approved by unanimous vote to amend Resolution No. R2013-0255 by deleting "No. CE1200521-01 with Early Childhood Enrichment Center, Inc. in the amount of \$237,786.33" throughout the Resolution.

Per Council Rule 9E, a motion was made by Ms. Simon, seconded by Mr. Germana and approved by unanimous vote to rescind the motion to amend Resolution No. R2013-0255 that deleted "No. CE1200521-01 with Early Childhood Enrichment Center, Inc. in the amount of \$237,786.33" throughout the Resolution.

On a motion by Mr. Germana with a second by Ms. Simon, Resolution No. R2013-0255 was considered and approved by majority vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules, with Mr. Rogers recusing himself from the vote.

6. MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS

Mr. Rogers announced that effective January 31, 2014, he will be resigning from County Council and has taken a position with Cleveland State University.
