## CUYAHOGA COUNTY FINANCE & BUDGETING COMMITTEE MEETING MONDAY, MARCH 24, 2014 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1<sup>ST</sup> FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Miller called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Miller asked Assistant Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Miller, Gallagher, Connally, Greenspan, Schron and Brady were in attendance and a quorum was determined.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

No public comments were given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 24, 2014 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Brady, seconded by Ms. Connally and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the February 24, 2014 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) <u>O2014-0004</u>: An Ordinance amending and replacing Chapter 701 of the Cuyahoga County Code, incorporating Chapters 706 and 707 of the Cuyahoga County Code into Chapter 701, and renumbering existing Chapters of Title 7 of the Cuyahoga County Code where appropriate to enact a comprehensive set of financial policies for Cuyahoga County.
