1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE

a) <u>R2013-0185:</u> A Resolution providing for an initial Cuyahoga County Criminal Justice Services review, to ensure coordination of county efforts to provide a fair, transparent, and accountable system of justice; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Gallagher addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2013-0185.

No further legislative action was taken on Resolution No. R2013-0185.

b) O2013-0017: An Ordinance enacting Chapter 603 of the Cuyahoga County Code to establish a Cuyahoga County Fire and Smoke Damper Inspection Program, and declaring the necessity that this Ordinance become immediately effective.

Mr. Michael Dever, Maintenance Administrator; Mr. Russell Bauman, representing Johnson Controls, Inc.; Mr. Andrew Conti, Facilities Maintenance Administrator; and Mr. Ed Morales, Assistant Law Director, addressed the Committee regarding Ordinance No. O2013-0017. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Dever, Mr. Bauman, Mr. Conti and Mr. Morales pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
