4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM APRIL 9, 2014 MEETING

 - a) R2014-0106: A Resolution making an award on RQ29741 to Youth Opportunities Unlimited in the amount not-to-exceed \$4,497,220.00 for the Temporary Assistance to Needy Families Summer Youth Employment Program for the period 5/1/2014 10/31/2014; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution, and

declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Joseph Gauntner, Administrator for Job & Family Services, Mr. Eric Matheny, Senior Executive of Employment Services at Youth Opportunities Unlimited, and Mr. David Merriman, Deputy Chief of Staff for Health & Human Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0106.
