CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS, PROCUREMENT & CONTRACTING COMMITTEE MEETING WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17, 2014 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS COMMITTEE ROOM A – 4TH FLOOR 11:00 AM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Vice-Chairman Germana called the meeting to order at 11:04 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Germana asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Germana, Conwell and Simon were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Miller entered the meeting shortly after the roll call was taken. Committee member Jones was absent from the meeting.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE SEPTEMBER 3, 2014 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Simon, seconded by Ms. Conwell and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the September 3, 2014 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2014-0222</u>: A Resolution authorizing a revenue generating Utility Agreement with City of Highland Heights for maintenance and repair of storm sewers, sanitary sewers and water lines located in County Sewer District No. 3; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreement and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
