

## MINUTES

## CUYAHOGA COUNTY HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES & AGING COMMITTEE MEETING WEDNESDAY, JUNE 4, 2014 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1<sup>ST</sup> FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

In the absence of Chairman Brady, Vice-Chairwoman Yvonne Conwell called the meeting to order at 1:04 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Ms. Conwell asked Deputy Clerk Muller to call the roll. Committee members Conwell, Jones, Miller and Greenspan were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Chairman Brady was absent from the meeting.

A motion was then made by Ms. Conwell, seconded by Mr. Jones and approved by unanimous vote to excuse Mr. Brady from the meeting.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT RELATED TO THE AGENDA

No public comments related to the agenda were given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM MAY 21, 2014 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Jones, seconded by Mr. Miller and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2014 meeting.

- 5. MATTER REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) <u>R2014-0145</u>: A Resolution authorizing amendments to contracts with various providers for job readiness, job search, job placement and job retention services for Ohio Works First cash assistance recipients for the period 7/1/2012 6/30/2014 to extend the time period to 6/30/2015, to change the scope of services, effective 7/1/2014, and for additional funds; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendments

and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective:

- 1) No. CE1200421-01 with El Barrio Incorporated in the amount not-to-exceed \$964,819.07.
- 2) No. CE1200422-01 with LNE & Associates, LLP in the amount not-to-exceed \$561,555.12.

Mr. Joseph Gauntner, Administrator for Job & Family Services, and Mr. Bob Math, representing the Department of Employment and Family Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0145. Discussion ensued.
