- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2014-0234</u>: A Resolution authorizing a Pay for Success contract with Mental Health Services for Homeless Persons, Inc. dba Frontline Service and Cuyahoga PFS, LLC in the amount not-to-exceed \$5,000,000.00 for an intervention program that provides various services addressing basic needs, housing placement, trauma therapy and family reunification services to children in foster care and homeless families of children in

foster care for the period 1/1/2015 - 12/15/2020; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. David Merriman, Interim Administrator of Cuyahoga Jobs and Family Services; Ms. Susan Neth, Chief Executive Officer of FrontLine Service; Mr. Eric Morse, Chief Operating Officer of FrontLine Service; Mr. Russell Spieth, Director of Family Services at FrontLine Service; Mr. Mark McDermott, Ohio Director of Enterprise Community Partners; and Professor David Crampton, Associate Professor of Social Work at Case Western Reserve University, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0234. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Mr. Merriman, Ms. Neth, Mr. Morse, Mr. Spieth, Mr. McDormott and Professor Crampton pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Miller with a second by Mr. Jones, Resolution No. R2014-0234 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.
