

## MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER

  - a) <u>R2014-0275</u>: A Resolution making an award on RQ31067 to United Way Services of Greater Cleveland in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,095,450.00 for fiscal agent services for emergency food purchases for Cuyahoga County residents for the period 1/1/2015 - 12/31/2015; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
