CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, JUNE 17, 2014 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

 - a) <u>R2014-0073</u>: A Resolution authorizing a revenue generating Underlying Agreement with City of Cleveland in the minimum amount of \$2,365,658.95 per annum for operation of jail services for City Prisoners, effective 6/1/2014; authorizing a Lease in connection with said agreement in the amount not-to-exceed \$1.00 per annum for use of the City's Central Prison Unit located at 1300 Ontario Street, 6th Floor,

Cleveland; authorizing the County Executive to execute the agreement and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Frank Bova, Sheriff, and Ms. Vallerie Propper, Special Assistant to County Executive FitzGerald, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0073. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Sheriff Bova and Ms. Propper pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
