CUYAHOGA COUNTY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT & PLANNING COMMITTEE MEETING MONDAY, MARCH 24, 2014 CUYAHOGA COUNTY JUSTICE CENTER COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 1ST FLOOR 3:00 P.M.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Schron called the meeting to order at 3:02 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Schron asked Deputy Clerk Muller to call the roll. Committee members Schron, Greenspan, Brady and Simon were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Jones entered the meeting shortly after the roll call was taken. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 3, 2014 MEETING

 - a) <u>R2014-0071</u>: A Resolution authorizing an Economic Development Fund Loan in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,500,000.00 to National Automotive Experts (NAE) Property Management II, LLC for assistance to purchase a facility located at 8370 Dow Circle, Strongsville; authorizing the Deputy Chief of Staff of Development or Director of Development to execute all documents consistent with said loan and

this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Arnold Lockett, Development Finance Analyst, Mr. Kirt Frye, representing National Automotive Experts (NAE) Property Management II, LLC; and Mr. Larry Benders, Director of the Department of Development, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2014-0071. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Lockett, Mr. Frye and Mr. Benders pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
