WHEREAS, the County is interested in purchasing property at 4205 Chester Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes a Purchase and Sale Agreement with Bricklayer Union Local #5 in the amount not-to-exceed \$325,000.00 for property located at 4205 Chester Avenue, Cleveland, Permanent Parcel Nos. 104-31-011 and 104-31-014.

SECTION 2. That the County Executive or his authorized designee is authorized to take all actions and to execute, acknowledge, deliver, obtain title work and/or title insurance, and/or file for and record all documents and instruments related to what is contemplated herein. To the extent an exemption for anything herein is needed, it is hereby granted.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County, the preservation of public peace, health, or safety in the County, and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through

signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Public Works, 2017, Approval of FAA Agreement to Improve the Runway and Safety Area for Runway 6/24, Project 3 and 4, Wet.

A. Scope of Work Summary:

1. Department of Public Works, is requesting Suspension of Rules and First Reading Adoption, for the transaction requesting authorization for the County Executive to enter into a Non-Federal Reimbursable Agreement with the Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and payment. The Agreement if for Preliminary Engineering for relocation of FAA Owned facilities, Materials and Construction Oversight of Phase Three/Four Construction at Cuyahoga County Airport in Cleveland, Ohio) is required to support the project to Improve the Runway Safety Area for Runway 6/24 with a not exceed cost of \$950,000.00. This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions for Preliminary Engineering for relocation of FAA owned facilities, Materials and Construction Oversight of Phase Three/Four Construction at Cuyahoga County Airport in Cleveland, Ohio. 2.
