## CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC SAFETY & JUSTICE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, DECEMBER 5, 2017 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR 1:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:07 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

a) <u>R2017-0216</u>: A Resolution making an award on RQ40136 to Selex, ES in the amount not-to-exceed \$870,338.00 for the Fixed Automated License Plate Recognition Project for the period 12/1/2017 - 6/30/2021; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Chief Erich Upperman, Chief of Police for the City of Fairview Park; Mr. Todd Ellsworth, Assistant Law Director; and Ms. Brandy Carney, Director of the Department of Public Safety & Justice Services, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2017-0216. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Chief Upperman, Mr. Ellsworth and Ms. Carney pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
