1. CALL TO ORDER

- 5. MATTER REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) R2017-0195: A Resolution awarding a Casino Revenue Fund grant in the amount of \$875,000.00 to City of Berea for the benefit of the Coe Lake Redevelopment Project, located at Coe Lake Park, John Mucklo Playground and Cuyahoga County Library—Berea Branch in the City of

Berea; authorizing the Director of Development or his/her designee to prepare all documents to effectuate said grant; authorizing the County Executive and/or Director of Development to execute all documents consistent with said grant and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Kahlil Seren, Research & Policy Analyst; the Honorable Cyril Kleem, Mayor of the City of Berea; Mr. Matthew Madzy, Director of Planning, Engineering & Development for the City of Berea; and Mr. Antonio Armagno, City Engineer with the City of Berea, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2017-0195. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Messrs. Seren, Kleem, Madzy and Armagno pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Gallagher with a second by Mr. Hairston, Resolution No. R2017-0195 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda for second reading.
