- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2018-0007: A Resolution making an award on RQ40411 to Project Management Consultants LLC in the amount not-to-exceed \$800,000.00 for owner's representative services in connection with the Justice Center Complex Project for the period 2/1/2018 1/31/2020; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and

declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Karen Lippmann, Deputy Director of Juvenile Court; and Dr. Andrew Hurtz, Vice President of Community Care at University Hospitals, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2018-0012. Discussion ensued.
