1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairwoman Simon called the meeting to order at 3:11 p.m.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MAY 2, 2018 MEETING

A motion was made by Ms. Simon, seconded by Ms. Brown and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the May 2, 2018 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) R2018-0110: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1600242-01 with United Labor Agency, Inc. for operation of the Workforce Service Center, job seekers and employer services, and management of the On-the-Job Training Program in connection with the Workforce Innovation

and Opportunity Act for the period 7/1/2016 - 6/30/2018 to extend the time period to 6/30/2019 and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$2,527,776.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Frank Brickner, Deputy Director/Chief Financial Officer of the Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Workforce Development Board; and Mr. David Megenhardt, Executive Director of United Labor Agency, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2018-0110. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Messrs. Brickner and Megenhardt pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Simon with a second by Ms. Brown, Resolution No. R2018-0110 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.
