Increase appropriations to allow the Law Department to hire contract temporary attorneys to assist preparing documents for release in response to subpoenas and public records request. These documents have to be thoroughly screened to exclude any documents that are protected under attorney-client privilege, the work product doctrine, and HIPAA. Funding comes from the General Fund.

Ms. Margaret Keenan, Director of the Office of Budget and Management; Mr. Jonathan McGory, Assistant Law Director; and Ms. Nora Hurley, Interim Law Director provided the Committee with a brief overview regarding an increase in appropriations to hire 11 contract temporary attorneys, the scope of work on the project, the bid process for the contract, start date for the project and possible obstacles for meeting deadlines. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Ms. Keenan, Mr. McGory and Ms. Hurley pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.
