

MINUTES CUYAHOGA COUNTY COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE MEETING TUESDAY, APRIL 23, 2019 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4TH FLOOR 4:00 PM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Council President Brady called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Council President Brady asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Councilmembers Tuma, Gallagher, Jones, Brown, Stephens, Simon, Miller and Brady were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmembers Schron and Conwell were in attendance shortly after the roll-call was taken.
