#### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:01 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Baker, Tuma and Brady were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Conwell was absent from the meeting. Councilmember Miller was also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JULY 16, 2019 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Brady, seconded by Mr. Tuma and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the July 16, 2019 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
  - a) R2019-0207: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1600252-01 with Applewood Centers, Inc. for Multisystemic Therapy/Multisystemic Therapy-Problem Sexual Behavior Services for adjudicated youth for the period 7/1/2016 6/30/2019 to extend the time period to 6/30/2020, to change the scope of services, effective 7/1/2019, and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$550,000.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the

amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Bridget Gibbons, Deputy Director of Programming for Juvenile Court, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2019-0207. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Ms. Gibbons pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Ms. Baker, Resolution No. R2019-0207 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

b) R2019-0208: A Resolution authorizing an amendment to Contract No. CE1700127-01 with OhioGuidestone for community-based treatment center management services for the period 7/1/2017 - 6/30/2019 to extend the time period to 6/30/2020, to change the scope of services, effective 7/1/2019, and for additional funds in the amount not-to-exceed \$1,300,000.00; authorizing the County Executive to execute the amendment and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Gibbons addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2019-0208. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Ms. Gibbons pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Gallagher with a second by Mr. Brady, Resolution No. R2019-0208 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

#### 6. DISCUSSION

a) Update regarding progress at County Jail

Mr. David Schilling, Interim Sheriff, addressed the Committee regarding improvements at the County jail including the intake process and suicide blankets. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Interim Sheriff Schilling pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

Ms. Brandy Carney, Chief Community Protection & Safety Officer; and Ms. Ronda Gibson, Administrator of Corrections, addressed the Committee regarding the jail population, number of beds available, suicide blankets and the City of Euclid jail facility. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Ms. Carney and Ms. Gibson pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/County Sheriff has recommended an award on RQ45119 to Trinity Services Group, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$18,612,898.75 for jail kitchen food services for the period 11/1/2019 - 12/31/2024; and

WHEREAS, the primary goal is to increase efficiencies in jail kitchen food operations while providing nutritional foods to County inmates; and

WHEREAS, the project is 100% funded by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

**SECTION 1.** That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes an award on RQ45119 to Trinity Services Group, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$18,612,898.75 for jail kitchen food services for the period 11/1/2019 - 12/31/2024.

**SECTION 2.** That the County Executive is authorized to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution.

**SECTION 3.** It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health or safety in the County and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the

expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**SECTION 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
