  - a) R2020-0039: A Resolution making an award on RQ45549 to Towards Employment, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$750,000.00 for a social enterprise to place and support job-ready, reentry workers into transitional jobs for the period 2/13/2020 2/14/2023; authorizing the County Executive to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.
