

MINUTES CUYAHOGA COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS, PROCUREMENT & CONTRACTING COMMITTEE MEETING WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 19, 2020 CUYAHOGA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE HEADQUARTERS C. ELLEN CONNALLY COUNCIL CHAMBERS – 4TH FLOOR 10:00 AM

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Tuma called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Tuma asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Tuma, Miller, Schron and Baker were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Conwell entered the meeting shortly after the roll call was taken.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY 5, 2020 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Schron, seconded by Mr. Miller and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the February 5, 2020 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2020-0043</u>: A Resolution declaring that public convenience and welfare requires rehabilitation of Lee Boulevard from Euclid Avenue to Forest Hills Boulevard in the City of East Cleveland; total estimated project cost \$1,801,000.00; finding that special assessments will neither be levied nor collected to pay for any part of the County's costs of said

improvement; authorizing the County Executive to enter into an agreement of cooperation with said municipality in connection with said project; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. Jessica French, Senior Project Manager, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2020-0043. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. French pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Mr. Schron, Resolution No. R2020-0043 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

b) <u>R2020-0044</u>: A Resolution approving Right-of-Way Exhibit No. M-5042 for rehabilitation of St. Clair Avenue Bridge No. 04.44 over Doan Brook in the City of Cleveland; authorizing the County Executive through the Department of Public Works to acquire said necessary Right-of-Way; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Ms. French addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2020-0044. Discussion ensued.

Committee members asked questions of Ms. French pertaining to the item, which she answered accordingly.

On a motion by Mr. Tuma with a second by Mr. Schron, Resolution No. R2020-0044 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.
