1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Baker, Tuma, Brady and Conwell were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Councilmembers Miller, Simon and Jones were also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MARCH 3, 2020 MEETING

 - a) Update on COVID-19

Mr. Terry Allan, Health Commissioner, provided the Committee with information regarding the demographics, number of confirmed cases, identified contacts, recovered cases, hospitalizations, testing and contact tracing related to COVID-19. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Allan pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

Dr. Akram Boutros, President and CEO of The MetroHealth System; and Dr. Julia Bruner, Interim Medical Director and Physician Executive for Ambulatory Operations for The MetroHealth System, addressed the Committee regarding testing, case projections, response timeline, best practices and strategies related to COVID-19. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Dr. Boutros and Dr. Bruner pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

Dr. Thomas Gilson, Medical Examiner, addressed the Committee regarding fatalities associated with COVID-19. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Dr. Gilson pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

Dr. Bruner; Mr. David Schilling, Interim Sheriff; and Ms. Ronda Gibson, Administrator of Corrections, provided the Committee with information regarding the jail population, transports, medical screenings and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) relating to mitigating COVID-19 at the County jail. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Dr. Bruner, Sheriff Schilling and Ms. Gibson pertaining to the item, which they answered accordingly.

WHEREAS, the County Executive/County Sheriff has recommended an award on RQ47359 to Trinity Services Group, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$8,926,659.00 for jail food services for the period 6/15/2020 - 6/14/2023; and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of the project are to reduce workload on county staff and corrections officers while ensuring that meal service remains consistent and meets all requirements of the jail administration; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded 100% by the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby makes an award on RQ47359 to Trinity Services Group, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$8,926,659.00 for jail food services for the period 6/15/2020 - 6/14/2023.

SECTION 2. That the County Executive is authorized to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with said award and this Resolution.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health or safety in the County and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of

the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
