1. CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at 1:03 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Mr. Gallagher asked Deputy Clerk Carter to call the roll. Committee members Gallagher, Baker, Tuma, Conwell were in attendance and a quorum was determined. Committee member Brady entered the meeting shortly after the rollcall was taken. Councilmembers Miller and Stephens were also in attendance.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments given.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE JUNE 30, 2020 MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Tuma, seconded by Mr. Gallagher and approved by unanimous vote to approve the minutes from the June 30, 2020 meeting.

- 5. MATTERS REFERRED TO COMMITTEE
 - a) <u>R2020-0146</u>: A Resolution authorizing an agreement with Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County in the amount not-to-exceed \$884,400.00 for residential and intensive outpatient treatment services in connection with the Medication Assisted Treatment II Drug Court Expansion Project for the period 5/31/2019 - 5/30/2024; authorizing the County Executive to execute

the agreement and all other documents consistent with this Resolution; and declaring the necessity that this Resolution become immediately effective.

Mr. Martin Murphy, Administrator of the Corrections Planning Board, addressed the Committee regarding Resolution No. R2020-0146. Discussion ensued.

Committee members and Councilmembers asked questions of Mr. Murphy pertaining to the item, which he answered accordingly.

On a motion by Ms. Conwell with a second by Mr. Brady, Resolution No. R2020-0146 was considered and approved by unanimous vote to be referred to the full Council agenda with a recommendation for passage under second reading suspension of the rules.

6. PRESENTATION

a) Cuyahoga County Police Officer Training

Chief Clayton Harris, Chief of Police for Cuyahoga Community (TRI-C) College; Ms. Carole Ballard, Director of Education and Training for the Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board of Cuyahoga County; Mr. Greg Truhan, Consultant for the ADAMHS Board; Mr. Ellis Johnson Jr., representing Tri-C; Chief Jack Hall, Chief of the Village of Westfield Police Department; Lt. George Lichman, representing the City of Rocky River Police Department; Mr. Pierre Bejjani, Chairman of the Cleveland American Middle East Organization; Mr. Scott Osiecki, Chief Executive Officer of the ADAMHS Board; and The Honorable Pamela Bobst, Mayor of the City of Rocky River, provided the Committee with an overview of the police training model and information related to communication and deescalation tactics, role of law enforcement in mass gatherings and bias free policing. Discussion ensued.

Resolution No. R2020-0159

WHEREAS, the County Executive on behalf of Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas/Corrections Planning Board has recommended a contract with Court Community Service, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$555,000.00 for court community placement and supervision services for probationers referred by the Court in connection with the Community Works Service Placement and Supervision Program for the period 1/1/2021 - 12/31/2023; and

WHEREAS, the goal of this project is to provide community service placement services for individuals referred by the Cuyahoga County Court of Common Pleas; and

WHEREAS, this project is funded 100% by the General Fund Revenue; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective in order that critical services provided by Cuyahoga County can continue and to provide for the usual, daily operation of a County entity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CUYAHOGA COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Cuyahoga County Council hereby authorizes a contract with Court Community Service, Inc. in the amount not-to-exceed \$555,000.00 for court community placement and supervision services for probationers referred by the Court in connection with the Community Works Service Placement and Supervision Program for the period 1/1/2021 - 12/31/2023.

SECTION 2. That the County Executive is authorized to execute the contract and all other documents consistent with this Resolution.

SECTION 3. It is necessary that this Resolution become immediately effective for the usual daily operation of the County; the preservation of public peace, health or safety in the County, and any additional reasons set forth in the preamble. Provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least eight members of Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon the earliest occurrence of any of the following: (1) its approval by the County Executive through signature, (2) the expiration of the time during which it may be disapproved by the County Executive under Section 3.10(6) of the Cuyahoga County Charter, or (3) its passage by at least eight members of Council after disapproval pursuant to Section 3.10(7) of the Cuyahoga County Charter. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
